11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 Article - Business Occupations and Professions

14 10-311.

15 (c) By rule, the Court of Appeals may:

16 (1) require a lawyer to pay an annual fee, not exceeding [\$20] \$30, to the

17 Fund; and

(2) specify the penalties, including suspension and disbarment, forpracticing law without having paid the annual fee.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 21 July 1, 1997.
