13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments

16 830.

- 17 (a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.
- 18 (2) "Crime" means an act committed by a person in the State that is:
- 19 (i) A crime under Article 27 of the Code;
- 20 (ii) A violation of the Transportation Article which is punishable by
- 21 imprisonment; or
- 22 (iii) A crime at common law.
- 23 (3) "Offense" means an act committed by a person in the State that is a
- 24 violation of the Transportation Article and is not punishable by imprisonment.
- (b) In addition to any other costs required by law, a circuit court shall impose on
- 26 a defendant convicted of a crime an additional cost of [\$40] \$45 in the case.

- 1 (c) In addition to any other costs required by law, the District Court shall impose 2 on a defendant convicted of a crime an additional cost of [\$30] \$35 in the case.
- 3 (d) In addition to any other costs required by law, a court shall impose on a
- 4 defendant convicted of an offense an additional cost of \$3 in the case, including cases in
- 5 which the defendant elects to waive the right to trial and pay the fine or penalty deposit
- 6 established by the Chief Judge of the District Court by administrative regulation.
- 7 (e) (1) All money collected under this section shall be paid to the Comptroller 8 of the State.
- 9 (2) The Comptroller shall deposit [\$20] \$22.50 from each fee collected
- 10 under subsection (b) of this section from a circuit court and [\$10] \$12.50 from each fee
- 11 collected under subsection (c) of this section from the District Court into the Maryland
- 12 Victims of Crime Fund established under § 854 of this subtitle.
- 13 (3) THE COMPTROLLER SHALL DEPOSIT \$2.50 FROM EACH FEE
- 14 COLLECTED UNDER SUBSECTIONS (B) AND (C) OF THIS SECTION INTO THE VICTIM
- 15 AND WITNESS PROTECTION AND RELOCATION FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER § 836 OF
- 16 THIS SUBHEADING.
- 17 [(3)] (4) The Comptroller shall deposit all other moneys collected under
- 18 subsections (b) and (c) of this section into the Criminal Injuries Compensation Fund
- 19 established under § 831 of this subheading.
- 20 [(4)] (5) The Comptroller shall pay out moneys from the Maryland Victims
- 21 of Crime Fund as approved by the Board of Victim Services under §§ 837 through 844 of
- 22 this subtitle.
- 23 (f) (1) From the first \$500,000 in fees collected under subsection (d) of this
- 24 section in each fiscal year, the Comptroller shall deposit one-half of each fee into the
- 25 Maryland Victims of Crime Fund and one-half of each fee into the Criminal Injuries
- 26 Compensation Fund.
- 27 (2) For fees collected under subsection (d) of this section in excess of
- 28 \$500,000 in each fiscal year, the Comptroller shall deposit the entire fee into the Criminal
- 29 Injuries Compensation Fund.
- 30 (g) A political subdivision may not be held liable under any condition for the
- 31 payment of sums under this section.
- 32 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 33 July 1, 1997.
