4 FOR the purpose of altering certain continuing education requirements for the renewal

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 Article - Business Occupations and Professions

18 8-308.

19 (a) (1) To qualify for renewal of a certificate under this subtitle, a certificate

20 holder shall earn during each 2-year certificate term at least [2] ONE continuing

21 education [units] UNIT in TWO OR MORE courses that the Board approves.

22 (2) A continuing education unit consists of 10 hours of study.

(b) [Notwithstanding subsection (a) of this section, if] IF a certificate is granted
to a certificate holder during the second year of a certificate term, the certificate holder
may renew the certificate for the next full term [without complying with the continuing
education requirements of the previous term as outlined in this section] BY EARNING AT
LEAST ONE-HALF OF A CONTINUING EDUCATION UNIT IN ONE OR MORE COURSES

6 THAT THE BOARD APPROVES.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect8 October 1, 1997.
