2 **Natural Resources - New Fishery Management Plans for Certain Varieties of Fish**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Natural Resources to prepare fishery
4 management plans for catfish, king mackerel, Spanish mackerel, tautog, black sea
5 bass, and scup; and generally relating to the preparation of fishery management
6 plans for certain fish.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

11 (1989 Replacement Volume and 1996 Supplement)

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - Natural Resources**

- 18 (22) SPANISH MACKEREL;

- 21 (25) SCUP.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
23 July 1, 1997.
