16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 20 (a) (1) A person is guilty of reckless driving if he drives a motor vehicle:
- 21 [(1)] (I) In wanton or willful disregard for the safety of persons or property;

- 23 [(2)] (II) In a manner that indicates a wanton or willful disregard for the
- 24 safety of persons or property.
- 25 (2) A PERSON IS GUILTY OF RECKLESS HOMICIDE BY MOTOR VEHICLE

27 (I) THE PERSON DRIVES A MOTOR VEHICLE:

1 2	1. IN WANTON OR WILLFUL DISREGARD FOR THE SAFETY OF PERSONS OR PROPERTY; OR
3	2. IN A MANNER THAT INDICATES A WANTON OR WILLFUI DISREGARD FOR THE SAFETY OF PERSONS OR PROPERTY; AND
5	(II) THE ACT RESULTS IN THE DEATH OF ANOTHER PERSON.
6	(b) A person is guilty of negligent driving if he drives a motor vehicle in a careless

- 9 (R) ANY PERSON WHO IS CONVICTED OF A VIOLATION OF § 21-901.1(A)(2) OF 10 THIS ARTICLE IS SUBJECT TO A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$5,000 OR IMPRISONMENT 11 FOR NOT MORE THAN 5 YEARS OR BOTH.
- 12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 13 October 1, 1997.
