12 13	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 17	(a) (1) The Secretary shall administer the Maryland Medical Assistance Program.
18	(2) The Program:

22 (ii) Shall provide, subject to the limitations of the State budget,

20 comprehensive medical and other health care services for indigent individuals or

- 23 comprehensive medical and other health care services for all eligible pregnant women
- 24 and, at a minimum, all children currently under the age of 1 whose family income falls
- 25 below 185 percent of the poverty level, as permitted by the federal law;

21 medically indigent individuals or both;

26 (iii) Shall provide, subject to the limitations of the State budget, family

(i) Subject to the limitations of the State budget, shall provide

27 planning services to women currently eligible for comprehensive medical care and other

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- 1 health care under item (ii) of this paragraph for 5 years after the second month following
- 2 the month in which the woman delivers her child;
- 3 (iv) Shall provide, subject to the limitations of the State budget,
- 4 comprehensive medical and other health care services for all children from the age of 1
- 5 year up through and including the age of 5 years whose family income falls below 133
- 6 percent of the poverty level, as permitted by the federal law;
- 7 (v) Shall provide, subject to the limitations of the State budget,
- 8 comprehensive medical care and other health care services for all children born after
- 9 September 30, 1983 who are at least 6 years of age but are under 19 years of age whose
- 10 family income falls below 100 percent of the poverty level, as permitted by federal law;
- 11 (vi) May include bedside nursing care for eligible Program recipients;

- 13 (vii) Shall provide services in accordance with funding restrictions
- 14 included in the annual State budget bill;
- 15 (VIII) SHALL PROVIDE, SUBJECT TO THE LIMITATIONS OF THE STATE
- 16 BUDGET, MEDICAL AND OTHER HEALTH CARE FOR CHILDREN FROM BIRTH
- 17 THROUGH AND INCLUDING THE AGE OF 3 YEARS AND PREGNANT WOMEN WHOSE
- 18 FAMILY INCOME FALLS BELOW 250% OF THE POVERTY LEVEL; AND
- 19 (IX) SHALL PROVIDE, SUBJECT TO THE LIMITATIONS OF THE STATE
- 20 BUDGET, MEDICAL AND OTHER HEALTH CARE FOR CHILDREN FROM THE AGE OF 4
- 21 YEARS UP THROUGH AND INCLUDING THE AGE OF 18 YEARS WHOSE FAMILY
- 22 INCOME FALLS BELOW 185% OF THE POVERTY LEVEL.
- 23 (3) Subject to restrictions in federal law or waivers, the Department may
- 24 impose cost-sharing on Program recipients.
