A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Interagency Coordinating Council on Community-Based Services for Adults with 3 Developmental Disabilities or Mental Disorders

4 FOR the purpose of establishing an Interagency Coordinating Council on

- 5 Community-Based Services for Adults with Developmental Disabilities or Mental
- 6 Disorders; specifying the membership, responsibilities, and duties of the Council;
- 7 establishing the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene as the lead agency for
- 8 supervising and monitoring a certain interagency system for regulating the
- 9 establishment, licensure, and operation of certain community-based residential
- 10 facilities or programs; specifying the responsibilities of the Department under this
- 11 Act; providing for the application of this Act; defining a certain term; and generally
- 12 relating to the establishment of an Interagency Coordinating Council on
- 13 Community-Based Services for Adults with Developmental Disabilities or Mental
- 14 Disorders.

15 BY adding to

- 16 Article Health General
- 17 Section 13-901 through 13-906, inclusive, to be under the new subtitle "Subtitle 9.
- 18 Interagency Coordinating Council on Community-Based Services for Adults
- 19 with Developmental Disabilities or Mental Disorders"
- 20 Annotated Code of Maryland
- 21 (1994 Replacement Volume and 1996 Supplement)

22 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

23 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

25 SUBTITLE 9. INTERAGENCY COORDINATING COUNCIL ON COMMUNITY-BASED

- 26 SERVICES FOR ADULTS WITH DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES OR MENTAL
- 27 DISORDERS.

29 IN THIS SUBTITLE, "COUNCIL" MEANS THE INTERAGENCY COORDINATING

30 COUNCIL ON COMMUNITY-BASED SERVICES FOR ADULTS WITH DEVELOPMENTAL 31 DISABILITIES OR MENTAL DISORDERS. 2

THIS SUBTITLE APPLIES ONLY TO THE LICENSING AND REGULATION OF
 COMMUNITY-BASED RESIDENTIAL PROGRAMS AND FACILITIES FOR THE PROVISION
 OF COMMUNITY-BASED SERVICES TO ADULTS WITH DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES
 OR MENTAL DISORDERS.

7 THE DEPARTMENT SHALL BE THE LEAD AGENCY FOR SUPERVISING AND
8 MONITORING A STATEWIDE INTERAGENCY SYSTEM FOR REGULATING THE
9 ESTABLISHMENT, OPERATION, AND LICENSING OF COMMUNITY-BASED
10 RESIDENTIAL FACILITIES OR PROGRAMS FUNDED BY:

(1) THE DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES ADMINISTRATION TO SERVE
 ADULTS WITH DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES UNDER TITLE 7, SUBTITLE 6 OF THIS
 ARTICLE;

14 (2) THE MENTAL HYGIENE ADMINISTRATION TO SERVE ADULTS WITH
15 MENTAL DISORDERS UNDER TITLE 10, SUBTITLE 5 OF THIS ARTICLE; OR

16 (3) THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES TO SERVE ADULTS THAT
17 REQUIRE A SUPPORTIVE HOUSING ARRANGEMENT IN ORDER TO RESIDE IN THE
18 COMMUNITY BECAUSE OF A PHYSICAL, MEDICAL, OR MENTAL DISABILITY
19 THROUGH THE "CARE PROGRAM", AS ESTABLISHED AND DEFINED UNDER ARTICLE
20 88A OF THE CODE.

22 THE DEPARTMENT SHALL:

(1) SERVE AS THE POINT OF ENTRY FOR PERSONS DESIRING
INFORMATION ON ESTABLISHING A COMMUNITY-BASED RESIDENTIAL PROGRAM
OR FACILITY TO PROVIDE COMMUNITY-BASED SERVICES TO ADULTS WITH
DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES OR MENTAL DISORDERS;

(2) PROVIDE THE DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES ADMINISTRATION,
THE MENTAL HYGIENE ADMINISTRATION, THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN
RESOURCES, AND OTHER STATE AGENCIES THAT ROUTINELY RECEIVE INQUIRES
FROM THE PUBLIC WITH INFORMATION ABOUT THE AVAILABILITY OF
COMMUNITY-BASED RESIDENTIAL SERVICES AND PROGRAMS FOR ADULTS WITH
DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES OR MENTAL DISORDERS THAT WILL ENABLE THE
AGENCIES TO RESPOND TO THE INQUIRIES ACCURATELY AND EFFECTIVELY; AND

34 (3) MONITOR THROUGH THE COUNCIL THE VARIOUS ASPECTS OF
35 ESTABLISHING, LICENSING, LOCATING, AND OPERATING COMMUNITY-BASED
36 RESIDENTIAL PROGRAMS AND FACILITIES FOR ADULTS WITH DEVELOPMENTAL
37 DISABILITIES OR MENTAL DISORDERS BY STATE AGENCIES TO ENSURE
38 COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE STATE LAW AND REGULATIONS.

2 (A) TO CARRY OUT THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE SECRETARY
3 SHALL ESTABLISH AN INTERAGENCY COORDINATING COUNCIL ON
4 COMMUNITY-BASED SERVICES FOR ADULTS WITH DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES
5 OR MENTAL DISORDERS.

6 (B) THE COUNCIL SHALL INCLUDE AT LEAST 1 REPRESENTATIVE FROM:

7 (1) THE MENTAL HYGIENE ADMINISTRATION;

8 (2) THE DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES ADMINISTRATION;

9 (3) THE ALCOHOL AND DRUG ABUSE ADMINISTRATION;

10 (4) THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES; AND

11 (5) THE OFFICE ON AGING.

12 (C) STAFF SUPPORT FOR THE COUNCIL SHALL BE PROVIDED BY THE13 DEPARTMENT.

15 THE COUNCIL SHALL:

(1) ESTABLISH AND MAINTAIN A MULTIPLE AGENCY INFORMATION
SYSTEM TO ASSURE STATE AGENCY ACCOUNTABILITY AND COORDINATION AND
ASSISTANCE IN STATE SERVICE PLANNING CAPABILITY IN REGARD TO THE
PROVISION OF COMMUNITY-BASED RESIDENTIAL SERVICES AND PROGRAMS FOR
ADULTS WITH DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES OR MENTAL DISORDERS;

(2) DEVELOP AND MAINTAIN UNIFORM APPLICATION AND LICENSING
 PROCEDURES FOR PERSONS DESIRING TO ESTABLISH A COMMUNITY-BASED
 RESIDENTIAL PROGRAM OR FACILITY TO PROVIDE COMMUNITY-BASED SERVICES
 TO ADULTS WITH DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES OR MENTAL DISORDERS;

(3) PROMOTE, AS PART OF EACH STATE AGENCY'S LICENSING
PROCEDURE, THE RECOMMENDATION THAT PERSONS SEEKING TO ESTABLISH A
COMMUNITY-BASED RESIDENTIAL FACILITY OR PROGRAM DURING THE PLANNING
AND DEVELOPMENT PHASE OF THE FACILITY OR PROGRAM INVOLVE AND
COMMUNICATE WITH THE COMMUNITY IN WHICH THE FACILITY OR PROGRAM WILL
BE LOCATED;

31 (4) DEVELOP CRITERIA FOR ANNOUNCED AND UNANNOUNCED
32 INSPECTIONS AND EVALUATIONS OF COMMUNITY-BASED RESIDENTIAL PROGRAMS
33 AND FACILITIES BY THE STATE AGENCIES;

(5) ESTABLISH QUALIFICATIONS AND TRAINING REQUIREMENTS
AMONG THE STATE AGENCIES FOR DIRECT CARE STAFF OF PERSONS HOLDING A
LICENSE TO OPERATE A COMMUNITY-BASED RESIDENTIAL PROGRAM OR FACILITY
FOR ADULTS WITH DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES OR MENTAL DISORDERS;

(6) PERIODICALLY REVIEW THE RESIDENTIAL PLACEMENT DECISION
 PROCEDURES OF THE STATE AGENCIES FOR ADULTS WITH DEVELOPMENTAL
 DISABILITIES OR MENTAL DISORDERS; AND

4 (7) MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE APPROPRIATE STATE AGENCY
5 ON THE DEVELOPMENT OF REGULATIONS NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT THE
6 PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBTITLE.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect8 October 1, 1997.
