CHAPTER ____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Anne Arundel County Sheriff's Salary**

3 FOR the purpose of increasing the annual salary of the Sheriff of Anne Arundel County;

4 providing that this Act does not apply to the salary or compensation of the
5 incumbent Sheriff; and generally relating to the salary of the Sheriff of Anne
6 Arundel County.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

16 2-309.

17 (c) (1) The Sheriff of Anne Arundel County shall receive a salary of:

18 (i) [\$44,500] \$48,700 in calendar year [1995] 1998;

19 (ii) [\$45,900] \$50,100 \$55,000 in calendar year [1996] 1999; AND

20 (iii) [\$47,300] \$51,500 in calendar year [1997] 2000; and

1 (iv) ~~[\$48,700]~~ \$52,900 in calendar year ~~[1998]~~ 2001 and thereafter. IN
2 CALENDAR YEAR 2000 AND EACH YEAR THEREAFTER, AN AMOUNT THAT EQUALS
3 THE PREVIOUS YEAR'S SALARY PLUS 2.8 PERCENT OF THAT SALARY.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III,
5 Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or
6 apply to the salary or compensation of the Sheriff of Anne Arundel County in office on
7 the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or
8 compensation of the Sheriff of Anne Arundel County shall take effect at the beginning of
9 the next following term of office.

10 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
11 October 1, 1997.
