## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

## 2 Creation of a State Debt - Harford County - Aberdeen Baseball Museum

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of \$400,000,
- 4 the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of Trustees of the Aberdeen
- 5 Baseball Museum, Inc. for certain acquisition purposes; providing for disbursement
- of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the grantee provide and expend 6
- 7 a matching fund; and providing generally for the issuance and sale of bonds
- 8 evidencing the loan.

## 9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

10 MARYLAND, That:

- 11 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 12 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Harford County
- 13 Aberdeen Baseball Museum Loan of 1997 in the total principal amount of \$400,000.
- 14 This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State general obligation
- 15 bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued, sold, and
- 16 delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of the State Finance and
- 17 Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 18 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as a
- single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under §
- 20 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 21 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer and
- 22 first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and delivering the
- 23 bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then shall be credited on
- 24 the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the Board of Public Works,
- 25 for the following public purposes, including any applicable architects' and engineers' fees:
- 26 as a grant to the Board of Trustees of the Aberdeen Baseball Museum, Inc. for the
- 27 acquisition of a building and the surrounding parking lot in Aberdeen to be used as the
- 28 Aberdeen Baseball Museum.
- 29 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in rate
- 30 and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and when due
- 31 and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years after the date of
- 32 issuance of the bonds.

- 1 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the
  2 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the Town of Aberdeen shall provide and expend
  3 a matching fund of \$200,000. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided,
  4 either directly or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or
  5 unappropriated. The fund may consist of real property. No part of the fund may consist of
  6 in kind contributions or funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act. In case of
  7 any dispute as to the amount of the matching fund or what money or assets may qualify as
  8 matching funds, the Board of Public Works shall determine the matter and the Board's
  9 decision is final. The grantee has until June 1, 1999, to present evidence satisfactory to
  10 the Board of Public Works that a matching fund will be provided. If satisfactory evidence
  11 is presented, the Board shall certify this fact to the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of
- 13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 14 June 1, 1997.

12 the loan shall be expended for the purposes provided in this Act.
