A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Teachers' Systems - Membership - University Staff**

3 FOR the purpose of clarifying eligibility for membership in the Teachers' Retirement
4 System and the Teachers' Pension System for certain employees of certain
5 educational institutions, who are currently eligible for membership.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - State Personnel and Pensions**

15 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, §§ 22-206 through 22-208
16 of this subtitle apply only to:

17 (1) an employee of a day school in the State under the authority and
18 supervision of a county board of education or the Baltimore City Board of School
19 Commissioners, employed as:

20 (i) an attendance officer;

21 (ii) a clerk;

22 (iii) a helping teacher;

23 (iv) a principal;

24 (v) a superintendent;

25 (vi) a supervisor; or

26 (vii) a teacher;

1 (2) [a faculty] AN employee of an educational institution supported by and
2 under the control of the State WHO IS:

3 (I) A MEMBER OF THE FACULTY;

4 (II) AN ACADEMIC ADMINISTRATOR;

5 (III) A RESEARCH ASSOCIATE; OR

6 (IV) A FACULTY RESEARCH ASSISTANT;

7 (3) a librarian or clerical employee of any library that is established or
8 operates under the Education Article; or

9 (4) a professional or clerical employee of a community college that is
10 established or operates under the Education Article.

11 (b) Sections 22-206 through 22-208 of this subtitle do not apply to:

12 (1) an individual who has elected to participate in an optional retirement

20 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, §§ 23-207 through 23-210
21 of this subtitle apply only to:

22 (1) an employee of a day school in the State under the authority and
23 supervision of a county board of education or the Baltimore City Board of School
24 Commissioners, employed as:

25 (i) a clerk;

26 (ii) a helping teacher;

27 (iii) a principal;

28 (iv) a superintendent;

29 (v) a supervisor; or

30 (vi) a teacher;

31 (2) [a faculty] AN employee of an educational institution supported by and
32 under the control of the State WHO IS:

33 (I) A MEMBER OF THE FACULTY;

34 (II) AN ACADEMIC ADMINISTRATOR;

9 program under Title 30 of this article;

10 (2) an individual who is employed under a federal public service

12 (3) a professional or clerical employee of the Department of Public
13 Libraries of Montgomery County who is participating in the employees' retirement system
14 of Montgomery County.

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
16 July 1, 1997.
