## 2 Workforce Reduction Act - Retirement Allowance for Deferred Retirements

- 3 FOR the purpose of providing that certain members of the Employees' Pension System
- 4 whose retirement under the Workforce Reduction Act was deferred shall receive
- 5 the greater of two retirement allowances computed as of certain dates; providing for
- 6 the construction of this Act; and generally relating to the computation of retirement
- 7 allowances of certain retirees under the Workforce Reduction Act.

- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
