1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Somerset County - Alcoholic Beverages**
3 **(Class D On- and Off-Sales)**

4 FOR the purpose of specifying that in Somerset County Class D beer, wine and liquor
5 licensees may sell liquor for on-sale consumption and beer and wine for both on-
6 and off-sale consumption; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Somerset
7 County.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

16 6-401.

17 (u) (1) In Somerset County the annual license fee is \$1,000.

18 (2) SPIRITUOUS LIQUORS MAY BE SOLD FOR ON-SALE CONSUMPTION
19 ONLY, BUT BEER AND WINE MAY BE SOLD FOR BOTH ON- AND OFF-SALE
20 CONSUMPTION.

21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
22 October 1, 1997.
