(2) SPIRITUOUS LIQUORS MAY BE SOLD FOR ON-SALE CONSUMPTION 18 19 ONLY, BUT BEER AND WINE MAY BE SOLD FOR BOTH ON- AND OFF-SALE 20 CONSUMPTION. SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 21
