2 **Harford County - Alcoholic Beverages**
3 **(Tasting Licenses)**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the amount of time during which an alcoholic beverages
5 licensee in Harford County may conduct tasting events; specifying the use of that
6 time; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Harford County.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

15 8-407.

16 (c) Each of the respective tasting or sampling licenses under this subsection is
17 effective for a maximum of [24] 52 days in any licensing period, WITH NO MORE THAN 1
18 DAY IN ANY WEEK.

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
20 October 1, 1997.
