2 1 on Aging and the Department of Human Resources, shall adopt regulations to implement 2 this subtitle. 3 (2) The regulations adopted under paragraph (1) of this subsection shall: 4 (i) Provide for the licensing of assisted living programs and the 5 renewal of licenses; 6 (ii) Require the Secretary to charge fees in a manner that will produce 7 funds not to exceed the actual direct and indirect costs to the Department for inspecting 8 assisted living program facilities and maintaining the licensure program for assisted living 9 programs under this subtitle; [and] (iii) Require the Department, during a survey or other inspection of an 10 11 assisted living program, to review the number of waivers granted to the program under 12 subsection (a)(3) of this section and determine whether a change in the program's 13 licensure status is warranted; AND (IV) PROVIDE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE MANAGEMENT OF 14 15 RESIDENT PROPERTY ENTRUSTED TO THE ASSISTED LIVING PROGRAM. SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 16
