17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 Article - Insurance

21 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES TO:

(1) INSURERS AND NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE PLANS THAT PROVIDE
INPATIENT HOSPITAL, MEDICAL, OR SURGICAL BENEFITS TO INDIVIDUALS OR
GROUPS ON AN EXPENSE-INCURRED BASIS UNDER HEALTH INSURANCE POLICIES
OR CONTRACTS THAT ARE ISSUED OR DELIVERED IN THE STATE; AND

(2) HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATIONS THAT PROVIDE
 INPATIENT HOSPITAL, MEDICAL, OR SURGICAL BENEFITS TO INDIVIDUALS OR

28 GROUPS UNDER CONTRACTS THAT ARE ISSUED OR DELIVERED IN THE STATE.

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(B) AN ENTITY SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION SHALL PROVIDE COVERAGE FOR
 EXPENSES INCURRED IN CONDUCTING AN ANNUAL MEDICALLY RECOGNIZED
 DIAGNOSTIC EXAMINATION, WHICH INCLUDES A DIGITAL RECTAL EXAMINATION
 AND A BLOOD TEST CALLED THE PROSTATE-SPECIFIC ANTIGEN (PSA) TEST, ON
 ENROLLEES AND INSUREDS WHO ARE:

6 (1) MEN AGE 50 OR OLDER AND ASYMPTOMATIC; AND

7 (2) MEN AGE 40 OR OLDER WITH A FAMILY HISTORY OF PROSTATE 8 CANCER OR OTHER PROSTATE CANCER RISK FACTORS.

9 (C) AN ENTITY SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION SHALL PROVIDE THE BENEFITS
10 REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION TO THE SAME EXTENT AS FOR ANY OTHER
11 MEDICAL CONDITION UNDER THE ENROLLEE'S OR INSURED'S CONTRACT OR
12 POLICY WITH THE ENTITY.

15 (N) THE PROVISIONS OF § 15-822 OF THE INSURANCE ARTICLE SHALL APPLY16 TO HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATIONS.
