8	(B) AN ENTITY SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION SHALL PROVIDE COVERAGE FOR

23	(3) WHEN USED FOR STAGING IN DETERMINING THE NEED FOR A BONE

25	(4) WHEN USED FOR MALE PATIENTS WHO ARE AT HIGH RISK FOR

27	(C) AN ENTITY SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION SHALL PROVIDE THE BENEFITS
