- 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 13 Article 33 Election Code
- 14 16B-5.
- 15 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY TO A VOTING SYSTEM IN WHICH BALLOTS
- 16 ARE ELECTRONICALLY TABULATED AT THE POLLING PLACE.
- 17 (B) A SYSTEM CERTIFIED BY THE STATE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD OF
- 18 ELECTION LAWS SHALL REQUIRE THAT THE BALLOT BE PRINTED IN A MANNER
- 19 THAT ALLOWS THE VOTER TO INDICATE A PREFERENCE FOR "NONE OF THE ABOVE"
- 20 IN THE ELECTION FOR ANY OFFICE.
- 21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 22 July 1, 1997.
