- 3 FOR the purpose of altering the definition of "point-of-service option" to specify that it
- 4 is a delivery system that permits a member or subscriber of a health maintenance
- 5 organization to receive services outside the health maintenance organization's
- 6 provider panel for any health care service that is covered under the member's or
- 7 subscriber's contract with the health maintenance organization.

- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 20 Article Health General
- 21 19-710.2.
- 22 (a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.
- 23 (2) "Carrier" means:
- 24 (i) An insurer;
- 25 (ii) A nonprofit health service plan;
- 26 (iii) A health maintenance organization;
- 27 (iv) A dental plan organization; or

- 1 (v) Any other person or organization that provides health benefit 2 plans subject to State regulation.
- 3 (3) "Point-of-service option" means a delivery system that permits a
- 4 member or subscriber of a health maintenance organization to receive [services] ANY
- 5 HEALTH CARE SERVICE outside the provider panel of the health maintenance
- 6 organization THAT IS COVERED under the terms and conditions of the member's or
- 7 subscriber's contract with the health maintenance organization.
- 8 (4) "Provider panel" means those providers with which a health
- 9 maintenance organization contracts to provide services to the health maintenance
- 10 organization's members or subscribers under the health maintenance organization's
- 11 health benefit plan.
- 12 (b) (1) If an employer, association, or other private group arrangement offers
- 13 health benefit plan coverage to employees or individuals only through a health
- 14 maintenance organization, the health maintenance organization with which the employer,
- 15 association, or other private group arrangement is contracting for the coverage shall offer,
- 16 or contract with another carrier to offer, a point-of-service option to the employer,
- 17 association, or other private group arrangement in conjunction with the health
- 18 maintenance organization as an additional benefit for an employee or individual, at the
- 19 employee's or individual's option, to accept or reject.
- 20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 21 July 1, 1997.
