- 22 (a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.

2 1 (2) "Carrier" means: 2 (i) An insurer; 3 (ii) A nonprofit health service plan; 4 (iii) A health maintenance organization; 5 (iv) A dental plan organization; or 6 (v) Any other person or organization that provides health benefit 7 plans subject to State regulation. (3) "Point-of-service option" means a delivery system HEALTH BENEFIT 9 PLAN that permits a member or subscriber of a health maintenance organization to 10 receive [services] ANY HEALTH CARE SERVICE outside the provider panel of the 11 health maintenance organization THAT IS COVERED under the terms and conditions of 12 the member's or subscriber's contract with the health maintenance organization. (4) "Provider panel" means those providers with which a health 13 14 maintenance organization contracts to provide services to the health maintenance 15 organization's members or subscribers under the health maintenance organization's 16 health benefit plan. 17 (b) (1) If an employer, association, or other private group arrangement offers 18 health benefit plan coverage to employees or individuals only through a health maintenance organization, the health maintenance organization with which the employer, 20 association, or other private group arrangement is contracting for the coverage shall offer, 21 or contract with another carrier to offer, a point-of-service option to the employer,
