A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Task Force on Maryland's Dairy Industry Recommendation - Sell-By Period

3 FOR the purpose of implementing certain recommendations of the Task Force on

- 4 Maryland's Dairy Industry; authorizing a certain milk processor to establish a
- 5 certain sell-by period for certain milk under certain circumstances; requiring a
- 6 processor establishing a certain sell-by period for certain milk to submit a certain
- 7 study to the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene; and generally relating to the
- 8 authority of a processor to establish a certain sell-by period.

9 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

- 12 Annotated Code of Maryland
- 13 (1996 Replacement Volume and 1996 Supplement)

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 Article - Health - General

17 21-426.

(a) In this section, "sell-by period" means the length of time a Grade A milkproduct may be kept for sale.

(b) (1) After a public hearing, the Secretary shall adopt rules and regulations
that establish a method for conspicuously marking, on the Grade A milk product
container, the last date on which the product may be sold.

23 (2) Each Grade A milk product container shall be marked as required by24 rules and regulations adopted under this subtitle.

(c) [A] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION, A Grade
A milk product that is cooled to, packaged, and stored at 45 degrees Fahrenheit or less
before it is purchased by or delivered to the ultimate consumer has a sell-by period of 14
days.

(D) (1) A GRADE A MILK PROCESSOR MAY ESTABLISH A SELL-BY PERIODTHAT IS LONGER THAN 14 DAYS.

(2) IF A GRADE A MILK PROCESSOR ESTABLISHES A SELL-BY PERIOD
 THAT IS LONGER THAN 14 DAYS, THE PROCESSOR SHALL SUBMIT TO THE
 SECRETARY AN INDICATOR SHELF LIFE STUDY THAT IS ACCEPTABLE TO THE
 SECRETARY WHICH DEMONSTRATES THAT THE GRADE A MILK PRODUCT HAS A
 SHELF LIFE EQUAL TO THE SELL-BY PERIOD PLUS AN ADDITIONAL 7 DAYS.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 October 1, 1997.
