- 2 Needle Exchange Program Repeal of Sunset
- 3 FOR the purpose of repealing the termination of the law relating to the AIDS Prevention
- 4 Sterile Needle and Syringe Exchange Pilot Program.
- 5 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
- 6 Chapter 360 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1994
- 7 Section 2
- 8 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 9 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 10 Chapter 360 of the Acts of 1994
- 11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency
- 12 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has
- 13 been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to
- 14 each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is
- 15 enacted. [It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and, at the end of 3 years from
- 16 the date of enactment, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act
- 17 shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.]
- 18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 19 June 1, 1997.
