A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Education - School Buses - Charging of Fees Prohibited**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting the charging of a fee for transporting public school  
4 students to school from their designated bus stop locations or from school to their  
5 designated bus stop locations.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
7 Article - Education  
8 Section 7-801(b)  
9 Annotated Code of Maryland  
10 (1997 Replacement Volume)

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article - Education**

14 7-801.

15 (b) (1) At its own expense, a county governing body may provide transportation  
16 for public school students in addition to the transportation provided by the State.

17 (2) A FEE MAY NOT BE CHARGED FOR TRANSPORTING PUBLIC SCHOOL  
18 STUDENTS:

19 (I) TO SCHOOL FROM THEIR DESIGNATED BUS STOP LOCATIONS;  
20 OR

21 (II) FROM SCHOOL TO THEIR DESIGNATED BUS STOP LOCATIONS.

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
23 July 1, 1997.
