## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Vehicle Laws - Stolen Registration Plates or Affixed Validation Tabs - No Fee for Replacement

FOR the purpose of prohibiting the Motor Vehicle Administration from charging a fee for the issuance of certain replacement registration plates, a replacement registration card, and replacement validation tabs to replace certain stolen registration plates or affixed validation tabs; making a technical change; and generally relating to the replacement of registration plates or affixed validation tabs that have been stolen.

24 (d) (1) If a current registration plate is lost, the owner of the vehicle for which 25 the registration was issued immediately shall place on the vehicle a temporary number 26 plate bearing the vehicle's registration number.

(2) The temporary plate shall be displayed as nearly as possible in the same 28 manner as provided in this subtitle for the registration plate. 2 which the registration was issued immediately shall place on the vehicle a temporary 3 number plate bearing the vehicle's registration number.
(2) The temporary plate shall be displayed as nearly as possible in the same 5 manner as provided in the subtitle for the registration plate. 7 registration plate is illegible, the owner of the vehicle for which the registration was 8 issued immediately shall place on the vehicle a temporary number plate bearing the vehicle's registration number.
(2) The temporary plate shall be displayed as nearly as possible in the same manner as provided in this subtitle for the registration plate.
(g) Within 48 hours after the loss, theft, or damage to the extent of illegibility of any current registration plate or any current validation tab that has been affixed to a registration plate, the owner of the vehicle for which the plate or tab was issued or the legal representative of the owner named in the certificate of title of the vehicle, as shown by the records of the Administration, shall notify the Administration and apply for replacement registration plates, a replacement registration card, and replacement validation tabs. The Administration shall supply the replacements on receiving information satisfactory to it and payment of the required fee.

(a) (1) [For]EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS

SUBSECTION, FOR the issuance of replacement registration plates, a replacement registration card, and replacement validation tabs, issued under [§ 13-415(d) through (f)]§ $13-415(\mathrm{G})$ of this title to replace a lost[, stolen,] or damaged registration plate or an affixed validation tab, the fee shall be established by the Administration.

(b) (1) [For] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS

SUBSECTION, FOR the issuance of replacement registration plates issued under Subtitle 6, Part II of this title, the fee shall be as established by the Administration.
(2) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY NOT CHARGE A FEE FOR REPLACEMENT REGISTRATION PLATES ISSUED UNDER SUBTITLE 6, PART II OF THIS TITLE TO REPLACE STOLEN REGISTRATION PLATES.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1997.
