A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Podiatrists - Scope of Practice**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the scope of practice for a licensed podiatrist by repealing

- 4 practice exclusions for triple arthrodesis, ankle fusions, and the surgical treatment
- 5 of ankle trauma, but excluding the surgical treatment of acute ankle fracture; and
- 6 generally relating to the scope of practice for podiatry.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

- 8 Article - Health Occupations
- 9 Section 16-101(f)
- 10 Annotated Code of Maryland
- 11 (1994 Replacement Volume and 1996 Supplement)

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article - Health Occupations**

15 16-101.

16 (f) (1) "Practice podiatry" means to diagnose or surgically, medically, or 17 mechanically treat any ailment of the human foot or ankle, or any ailment of the

- 18 anatomical structures that attach to the human foot.
- 19 (2) "Practice podiatry" does not include:
- 20 (i) [Triple arthrodesis, ankle fusions, or surgical] SURGICAL 21 treatment of ACUTE ankle [trauma] FRACTURE; or
- 22 (ii) Administration of an anesthetic, other than a local anesthetic.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 23 24 October 1, 1997.
