A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Baltimore City - Tort Claims Act - Baltimore City Police Department

3 FOR the purpose of including the Baltimore City Police Department within the definition
4 of local government for purposes of the Local Government Tort Claims Act; and
5 generally relating to the Baltimore City Police Department.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings

14 5-401.

15 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.

16 (b) "Actual malice" means ill will or improper motivation.

17 (c) (1) "Employee" means any person who was employed by a local government
18 at the time of the act or omission giving rise to potential liability against that person.

19 (2) "Employee" includes:

20 (i) Any employee, either within or without a classified service or merit
21 system;

22 (ii) An appointed or elected official; or

23 (iii) A volunteer who, at the request of the local government, and
24 under its control and direction, was providing services or performing duties.

25 (d) "Local government" means:

26 (1) A chartered county established under Article 25A of the Code;

27 (2) A code county established under Article 25B of the Code;

1 (3) A board of county commissioners established or operating under Article
2 25 of the Code;

3 (4) Baltimore City;

4 (5) A municipal corporation established or operating under Article 23A of
5 the Code;

6 (6) The Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission;

7 (7) The Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission;

8 (8) The Northeast Maryland Waste Disposal Authority;

9 (9) A community college or board of trustees for a community college
10 established or operating under Title 16 of the Education Article;

11 (10) A county public library or board of trustees of a county public library
12 established or operating under Title 23, Subtitle 4 of the Education Article;

13 (11) The Enoch Pratt Free Library or Board of Trustees of the Enoch Pratt
14 Free Library;

15 (12) The Washington County Free Library or the Board of Trustees of the
16 Washington County Free Library;

17 (13) A special taxing district;

18 (14) A nonprofit community service corporation incorporated under
19 Maryland law that is authorized to collect charges or assessments;

20 (15) Housing authorities created under Article 44A of the Code;

21 (16) A sanitary district, sanitary commission, metropolitan commission, or
22 other sewer or water authority established or operating under public local law or public
23 general law;

24 (17) The Baltimore Metropolitan Council;

25 (18) The Howard County Economic Development Authority;

26 (19) The Howard County Mental Health Authority; [and]

27 (20) A commercial district management authority established by a county or
28 municipal corporation if provided under local law; AND

29 (21) THE BALTIMORE CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT.

30 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
31 October 1, 1997.
