2 Vehicle Laws - Registration - Commemorative Plates for Supporters of Dog and Cat

3 Sterilization

4	FOR the purpose	of requiring the	Motor Vehicle	Administration	to issue specially

- 5 designed commemorative registration plates to enhance public awareness of the
- 6 State's commitment to manage the population of dogs and cats through sterilization
- 7 and to subsidize the efforts of certain entities that humanely sterilize dogs and cats
- 8 in the State; requiring the Governor to appoint a certain number of individuals to a
- 9 committee to develop, organize, and implement a statewide contest to design the
- 10 commemorative plates; restricting the issuance of the commemorative plates to
- 11 certain classes of vehicles; requiring the Administration to charge an additional
- registration fee for the commemorative plates under certain circumstances;
- requiring the Administration to transfer a certain portion of the additional
- registration fee charged for commemorative plates issued under this Act to certain
- 15 counties monthly; requiring counties receiving funds under this Act either to
- distribute the funds received in a certain manner to certain entities or to return the
- funds to the Administration; providing for the allocation of funds returned by a
- county to the Administration; and generally relating to the issuance of
- 19 commemorative registration plates by the Administration.

- 25 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 26 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 29 (A) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ISSUE SPECIAL COMMEMORATIVE
- 30 ORIGINAL OR SUBSTITUTE REGISTRATION PLATES TO:
- 31 (1) ENHANCE PUBLIC AWARENESS OF THE STATE'S COMMITMENT TO
- 32 MANAGE THE POPULATION OF DOGS AND CATS THROUGH STERILIZATION; AND

1 2	(2) SUBSIDIZE THE EFFORTS OF ENTITIES THAT HUMANELY STERILIZE DOGS AND CATS.
5 6 7	(B) THE OWNER OF A VEHICLE, OR A LESSEE OF THE VEHICLE UNDER A LEASE NOT INTENDED AS SECURITY, OR A DIRECTOR, OFFICER, EMPLOYEE, OR PARTNER OF A BUSINESS ENTITY THAT OWNS THE VEHICLE CONSIDERED ELIGIBLE BY THE ADMINISTRATION MAY APPLY TO THE ADMINISTRATION FOR THE ASSIGNMENT OF A COMMEMORATIVE REGISTRATION PLATE UNDER THIS SECTION IF THE VEHICLE IS INCLUDED IN ONE OF THE FOLLOWING CLASSES:
9	(1) A CLASS A (PASSENGER) VEHICLE;
10	(2) A CLASS B (FOR HIRE) VEHICLE;
11 12	(3) A CLASS E (TRUCK) VEHICLE WITH A MANUFACTURER'S RATED CAPACITY OF 1 TON OR LESS;
13	(4) A CLASS G (TRAILER) VEHICLE; OR
14	(5) A CLASS M (MULTIPURPOSE) VEHICLE.
17 18	(C) (1) IN ADDITION TO THE ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEE OTHERWISE REQUIRED UNDER THIS TITLE, AN OWNER OF A VEHICLE ASSIGNED A COMMEMORATIVE REGISTRATION PLATE UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL PAY THE FEE SET BY THE ADMINISTRATION WHEN THE NEW REGISTRATION PLATES ARE ISSUED TO THE VEHICLE UNDER THIS SECTION.
20 21	(2) (I) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL SET THE FEE AT A LEVEL THAT WILL ENABLE THE ADMINISTRATION TO RECOVER ITS COSTS UNDER THIS SECTION.
	(II) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL CHARGE A FEE THAT IS SUFFICIENT TO RESULT IN A SURPLUS OF AT LEAST 12 AFTER COSTS ARE SUBTRACTED.
	(III) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL RETAIN A PORTION OF THE FEE THAT IS SUFFICIENT TO ALLOW THE ADMINISTRATION TO RECOVER ANY COSTS OF ISSUING AND DISTRIBUTING COMMEMORATIVE PLATES UNDER THIS SECTION.
30	(IV) ANY SURPLUS MONEYS REMAINING AFTER THE ADMINISTRATION HAS RECOVERED THE COSTS OF ISSUING A COMMEMORATIVE PLATE UNDER THIS SECTION MAY NOT BE RETAINED BY OR TRANSFERRED TO ANY AGENCY OF THE STATE FOR ANY PURPOSE.
	(V) NOTWITHSTANDING SUBPARAGRAPH (IV) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, THE SURPLUS MONEYS MAY BE RETAINED FOR THE PURPOSE DESCRIBED IN PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION.
37 38	(3) THE SURPLUS MONEYS SHALL BE DISBURSED BY THE ADMINISTRATION TO EACH COUNTY MONTHLY IN A PROPORTIONATE SHARE EQUAL TO THE PERCENTAGE OF THE TOTAL NUMBER OF REGISTRATION PLATES ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION THAT ARE ISSUED TO RESIDENTS OF THE RESPECTIVE COUNTY.

1	(4) EACH COUNTY RECEIVING FUNDS UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL:
2 3	(I) DISTRIBUTE THE ENTIRETY OF THE FUNDS PROMPTLY TO ENTITIES THAT HUMANELY STERILIZE DOGS AND CATS WITHIN THAT COUNTY; OR
4 5	(II) RETURN THE ENTIRETY OF THE FUNDS PROMPTLY TO THE ADMINISTRATION.
	(5) FUNDS RECEIVED BY A COUNTY UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE APPLIED IN ADDITION TO AND NOT IN SUBSTITUTION OF EXISTING FUNDING BY THE COUNTY OF ENTITIES THAT HUMANELY STERILIZE DOGS AND CATS.
	(6) ANY FUNDS RETURNED TO THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL BE APPORTIONED AMONG THOSE COUNTIES RECEIVING FUNDS IN EQUAL PROPORTIONS.
12 13	(7) EACH COUNTY SHALL DECIDE WHICH ENTITIES WILL RECEIVE FUNDS DISBURSED UNDER THIS SECTION.
	(8) NO PORTION OF THE FEE MAY BE CREDITED TO THE GASOLINE AND MOTOR VEHICLE REVENUE ACCOUNT FOR DISTRIBUTION UNDER $\$$ 8-403 OR $\$$ 8-404 OF THE TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE.
	(D) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS NOT INCONSISTENT WITH THE MARYLAND VEHICLE LAW TO GOVERN THE ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES UNDER THIS SECTION.
22	(E) THE ADDITIONAL FEE TO THE ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEE REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION IS NOT REQUIRED FOR SPECIAL REGISTRATION OF A VEHICLE THAT IS EXEMPT UNDER § 13-903 OF THIS TITLE, OR A VEHICLE WITH A SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE RECOGNIZING:

36 37	(2) THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT A COMMITTEE OF FIVE INDIVIDUALS FROM A LIST OF RECOMMENDATIONS SUBMITTED BY HUMANE ORGANIZATIONS IN THE STATE TO DEVELOP, ORGANIZE, AND IMPLEMENT A STATEWIDE CONTEST TO DESIGN THE COMMEMORATIVE PLATES TO BE ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION.

- 1 (3) A SPECIAL REGISTRATION NUMBER OR DESIGN ASSIGNED UNDER
- 2 THIS SECTION SHALL BE DISPLAYED ON THE REGISTRATION PLATES FOR THE
- 3 VEHICLE.
- 4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 5 October 1, 1997.
