## 10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 12 Article 27A - Public Defender

14 (a) The Office of Public Defender is hereby established in the executive branch of

15 the government of the State of Maryland. The head of the Office shall be the Public

16 Defender, who shall be appointed by the board of trustees, and who shall serve at the

17 pleasure of the board of trustees. To be qualified for appointment as Public Defender, a

18 person must be an attorney-at-law, admitted to practice law in the State of Maryland by

19 the Court of Appeals of Maryland, and engaged in the practice of law for a period of five

20 (5) years prior to his appointment. The Public Defender shall receive such salary as

21 provided in the budget, BUT NOT LESS THAN WHICH AMOUNT SHALL BE EQUAL TO

22 THE SALARY OF A AN ASSOCIATE JUDGE OF THE CIRCUIT COURT. [and] THE PUBLIC

23 DEFENDER shall not engage in the private practice of law.
