10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## 12 Article - Natural Resources

13 4-710.

(a) (1) A person may not catch finfish for any purpose in the tidal waters of the
State by use of any gig, gig iron, purse net, beam trawl, otter trawl, trammel net, troll net,
or drag net.

17 (2) A PERSON MAY NOT CATCH SUMMER FLOUNDER FOR COMMERCIAL18 HARVEST IN THE TIDAL WATERS OF THE STATE BY BEAM TRAWL OR OTTER TRAWL.

- (3) Any person who violates this section by catching fish with any of the
  equipment or devices referred to in this subsection, with the exception of a gig or gig iron,
  is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding \$1,000 or
  imprisonment not exceeding one year, or both, with costs imposed in the discretion of the
  court. Any person who illegally catches fish with a gig or gig iron is subject to the
- 24 penalties provided by this title.

25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 26 October 1, 1997.
