A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Crimes - Butane Lighters and Canisters - Distribution to Minors

- 3 FOR the purpose of including butane in the list of inhalants and noxious substances that
- 4 may not be smelled or inhaled; prohibiting the distribution of butane lighters and
- 5 butane replacement canisters to minors; establishing penalties for violation of the
- 6 prohibition; and generally relating to inhalation of butane and distribution of
- butane lighters and butane replacement canisters to minors.

- 9 Article 27 Crimes and Punishments
- 10 Section 301 and 301A
- 11 Annotated Code of Maryland

- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 Article 27 - Crimes and Punishments

- 17 (a) It is unlawful for any person to deliberately smell or inhale such excessive
- 18 quantities of any drugs, or any other noxious substances or chemicals containing wholly or
- 19 in part any ketones, aldehydes, BUTANE, butyl nitrite, nitrous oxide, methyl benzene,
- 20 organic acetates, ether, chlorinated hydrocarbons, fluorinated hydrocarbons, or any other
- 21 substances containing solvents releasing toxic vapors, as cause conditions of intoxication,
- 22 inebriation, excitement, stupefaction or dulling of the brain or nervous system. This
- 23 section applies with particularity to fingernail polish, model airplane glue, or any other
- 24 substance or chemical which has the aforementioned effect upon the brain or nervous
- 25 system when smelled or inhaled; provided, that nothing in this section shall be interpreted
- 26 as applying to the inhalation of any anaesthesia for medical or dental purposes, and
- 27 further provided, that nothing in this section shall be interpreted as applying to the
- 28 controlled dangerous substances as defined in this subheading.
- 29 (b) Any person violating any provision of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor
- 30 and, upon conviction, is subject to a fine not exceeding \$500, or imprisonment not
- 31 exceeding six months, or both.

- 2 (a) [No person may] A PERSON MAY NOT distribute, or possess with intent to
- 3 distribute, to any other person any of the substances enumerated in § 301 of this article if
- 4 such distribution is with the intent to induce unlawful inhaling of the substance or is with
- 5 the knowledge that the other person will unlawfully inhale the substance.
- 6 (b) [No person may] A PERSON MAY NOT instruct another person in the
- $7\,$ practice of unlawful inhaling as defined in $\S~301$ of this article.
- 8 (C) A PERSON MAY NOT DISTRIBUTE A BUTANE LIGHTER OR A BUTANE 9 REPLACEMENT CANISTER TO A MINOR.
- 5 KEI LACEMENT CAMBIER TO A MINOR.
- 10 [(c)] (D) (1) A person who violates [any provision] SUBSECTION (A) OR (B) of
- 11 this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, is subject to a fine not
- 12 exceeding \$500, or imprisonment not exceeding 18 months, or both.
- [(d)] (2) A person found guilty of a second or subsequent violation of [any
- 14 provision] SUBSECTION (A) OR (B) of this section is subject to a fine not exceeding
- 15 \$1,000, or imprisonment not exceeding 3 years, or both.
- 16 (3) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION IS
- 17 GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND, UPON CONVICTION, IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT
- 18 EXCEEDING \$1,000, OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 18 MONTHS, OR BOTH.
- 19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 20 October 1, 1997.
