- 19 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "IMPROPERLY REGISTERED MOTOR VEHICLE" MEANS
- 20 ANY MOTOR VEHICLE THAT:
- 21 (1) IS OWNED BY A PERSON WHO RESIDES IN THE STATE; BUT
- 22 (2) IS REGISTERED IN ANOTHER STATE.
