1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Frederick County - Alcoholic Beverages**
3 **(Stadium Franchise Business Entity)**

4 FOR the purpose of including an additional business entity in Frederick County to those
5 professional baseball team franchises which may hold a stadium beer on-sale
6 alcoholic beverages license; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in
7 Frederick County.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

16 8-211.1.

17 (a) The Frederick County Board of License Commissioners may issue a stadium
18 beer on-sale license to the owner of any professional baseball team franchise, whether
19 the franchise is a partnership, [or] corporation, OR LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
21 October 1, 1997.
