14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

18 (e) THE GOVERNING BODY OF FREDERICK COUNTY AND OF A MUNICIPAL 19 CORPORATION IN FREDERICK COUNTY MAY GRANT, BY LAW, A PROPERTY TAX 20 CREDIT UNDER THIS SECTION AGAINST THE COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION 21 PROPERTY TAX IMPOSED ON REAL PROPERTY THAT IS:

- 1 (2) USED EXCLUSIVELY FOR PRIMARY OR SECONDARY EDUCATIONAL 2 PURPOSES.
- 3 (F) A taxpayer may apply for a property tax credit under this section on or before 4 October 1 of the taxable year.
- 5 [(f)] (G) (1) Except as provided under paragraph (2) of this subsection, a 6 property tax credit granted under this section shall continue until the property is 7 conveyed.
- 8 (2) A property tax credit granted under subsection (d) OR (E) of this section 9 shall continue as long as the property is in compliance with the terms of that subsection.
- 10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 11 July 1, 1997.
