## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Anne Arundel County - Alcoholic Beverages**  
3 **(Board of License Commissioners - Administrators)**4 FOR the purpose of altering the number of full-time administrators within the Board of  
5 License Commissioners of Anne Arundel County; eliminating the position of  
6 secretary to the Board; correcting outmoded references; and generally relating to  
7 alcoholic beverages in Anne Arundel County.8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
9 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages  
10 Section 15-112(d)  
11 Annotated Code of Maryland  
12 (1996 Replacement Volume)13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:15 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

17 (d) (1) (I) [In] THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SUBSECTION APPLY ONLY IN  
18 Anne Arundel County.19 (II) IN THIS SUBSECTION, "BOARD" MEANS THE BOARD OF LICENSE  
20 COMMISSIONERS OF ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY.21 [(1)] (2) [the] THE Mayor, Counsellor and Aldermen of Annapolis [shall  
22 have the power to] MAY make and enforce [such rules,] regulations and restrictions, in  
23 addition to, or in substitution of, those contained in this article, but not inconsistent  
24 therewith, as in the judgment of the Mayor, Counsellor and Aldermen of the City of  
25 Annapolis would give the municipality more effective control of each of the places of  
26 business.27 [(2)] (3) (I) In addition to the powers given to the Board [of License  
28 Commissioners for Anne Arundel County] in subsections (a) and (b) of this section, the  
29 Board is authorized to employ one part-time chief inspector at an annual salary of \$8,000,  
30 and 12 part-time inspectors at an annual salary of \$5,000 each. In addition to this salary,

1 each of the inspectors shall receive a monthly expense of \$150 per month, subject to the  
2 approval of the State Comptroller.

3 (II) The 13 inspectors [appointed for Anne Arundel County] have all  
4 the powers of a peace officer or a constable or sheriff of [the] THIS State [of Maryland],  
5 and shall make oath to faithfully perform the duties entrusted to them, as provided in  
6 Article I, § 9 of the Constitution of the State of Maryland, and shall furnish bond in the  
7 penalty of \$2,000 to the Board [of License Commissioners of Anne Arundel County and  
8 the Board of County Commissioners of] AND Anne Arundel County jointly, conditioned  
9 "that inspector shall well and faithfully execute the office in all things appertaining  
10 thereto". The cost of the bond shall be paid by the County [Commissioners of Anne  
11 Arundel County]. The inspectors for Anne Arundel County are known as the "liquor  
12 inspectors for Anne Arundel County".

13 (III) There [shall be a] ARE TWO full-time [administrator]  
14 ADMINISTRATORS to the Board whose annual salary shall be fixed by the Board as in a  
15 general Anne Arundel County classified salary schedule, within pay grade 16. [There  
16 shall be a full-time secretary to the Board whose annual salary shall be fixed by the Board  
17 as in a general county classified salary schedule, within pay grade 13.]

18 (IV) There [shall be] IS an attorney to the Board[, at an] WHOSE  
19 annual salary [of] IS \$8,000.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
21 October 1, 1997.
