11	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
13	Article - Natural Resources
14	5-1606.
15 16	(a) (1) For the following land use categories, tracts having less than 20% of the net tract area in forest cover shall be afforested up to 20% of the net tract area:
17	(i) Agriculture and resource areas; and
18	(ii) Medium density residential areas.
19 20	(2) For the following land use categories, tracts having less than 15% of the net tract area in forest cover shall be afforested up to 15% of the net tract area:
21	(i) Institutional development areas;
22	(ii) High density residential areas;
23	(iii) Mixed use and planned unit development areas; and
24	(iv) Commercial and industrial use areas.

25 (3) Afforestation requirements must conform to the conditions in §§ 5-1607

 $26\,$ and $5\text{-}1610\,$ of this subtitle, including payment into the Forest Conservation Fund, if

 $27\,$ afforestation on-site or off-site cannot be reasonably accomplished.

1 (4) (i) The afforestation requirements under this subsection shall be 2 accomplished within 1 year or 2 growing seasons after the completion of the development 3 project.

4 (ii) If afforestation cannot be reasonably accomplished on-site or
5 off-site, the requirement to contribute money to a Forest Conservation Fund under §
6 5-1610 of this subtitle shall be met within 90 days after the completion of the
7 development project.

8 (5) THE AFFORESTATION REQUIREMENTS UNDER PARAGRAPH (2) OF
9 THIS SUBSECTION DO NOT APPLY TO COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL USE AREAS IN
10 FREDERICK COUNTY.

11 (b) There is a forest conservation threshold established for all land use categories 12 as provided in subsection (c) of this section. The forest conservation threshold means the 13 percentage of the net tract area at which the reforestation requirement changes from a 14 ratio of 1/4 acre planted for every 1 acre removed to a ratio of 2 acres planted for every 15 1 acre removed.

(c) After every reasonable effort to minimize the cutting or clearing of trees and
other woody plants is exhausted in the development of a subdivision plan and grading and
sediment control activities and implementation of the forest conservation plan, the forest
conservation plan shall provide for reforestation, or payment into the Forest
Conservation Fund, according to the formula set forth in subsection (b) of this section

and consistent with the following forest conservation thresholds for the applicable landuse category:

(1) Agricultural and resource areas: 50% of net tract area;
(2) Medium density residential areas: 25% of net tract area;
(3) Institutional development areas: 20% of net tract area;
(4) High density residential areas: 20% of net tract area;
(5) Mixed use and planned unit development areas: 15% of net tract area;
(6) Commercial and industrial use areas: 15% of net tract area.

30 (d) (1) Subject to the provisions of paragraph (2) of this subsection, for all
31 existing forest cover measured to the nearest 1/10 acre cleared on the net tract area above
32 the applicable forest conservation threshold, the area of forest removed shall be
33 reforested at a ratio of 1/4 acre planted for every 1 acre removed.

34 (2) Each acre of forest retained on the net tract area above the applicable
35 forest conservation threshold shall be credited against the total number of acres required
36 to be reforested under paragraph (1) of this subsection.

(e) For all existing forest cover measured to the nearest 1/10 acre cleared on the
net tract area below the applicable forest conservation threshold, the area of forest
removed shall be reforested at a ratio of 2 acres planted for every 1 acre removed.

1 (f) (1) The reforestation requirements under this section shall be accomplished 2 within 1 year or 2 growing seasons after completion of the development project.

3 (2) If reforestation cannot be reasonably accomplished on-site or off-site,
4 the requirement to contribute money to a Forest Conservation Fund under § 5-1610 of
5 this subtitle shall be met within 90 days after completion of the development project.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 October 1, 1997.
