CHAPTER ____

- 1 AN ACT concerning
- 2 Creation of a State Debt St. Mary's County St. Clement's Island Potomac River 3 Museum
- 4 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of \$81,500,
- 5 the proceeds to be used as a grant to the Board of County Commissioners of St.
- 6 Mary's County for certain acquisition, development, or improvement purposes;
- 7 providing for disbursement of the loan proceeds, subject to a requirement that the
- 8 grantee provide and expend a matching fund; and providing generally for the
- 9 issuance and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.
- 10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 11 MARYLAND, That:
- 12 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 13 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the St. Mary's
- 14 County St. Clement's Island Potomac River Museum Loan of 1997 in the total
- 15 principal amount of \$81,500. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and
- 16 delivery of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of
- 17 Public Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with §§ 8-117 through 8-124
- 18 of the State Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 19 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as a 20 single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under §
- 21 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 22 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer and
- 23 first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and delivering the
- 24 bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then shall be credited on
- 25 the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the Board of Public Works,
- 26 for the following public purposes, including any applicable architects' and engineers' fees:

- $1\,$ as a grant to the Board of County Commissioners of St. Mary's County, the $\underline{\text{(the}}$ overseers
- 2 of the St. Clement's Island Potomac River Museum (referred and referred to hereafter
- 3 in this Act as "the grantee") for the repair, renovation, expansion, and equipping capital
- 4 equipping of the St. Clement's Island Potomac River Museum and associated facilities,
- 5 in St. Mary's County.
- 6 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in rate 7 and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and when due 8 and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years after the date of
- 9 issuance of the bonds.
- 10 (5) Prior to the payment of any funds under the provisions of this Act for the
- 11 purposes set forth in Section 1(3) above, the grantee shall provide and expend a matching
- 12 fund of \$50,000. No part of the grantee's matching fund may be provided, either directly
- 13 or indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or unappropriated. No part
- 14 of the fund may consist of real property, in kind contributions, or funds expended prior to
- 15 the effective date of this Act. In case of any dispute as to the amount of the matching
- 16 fund or what money or assets may qualify as matching funds, the Board of Public Works
- 17 shall determine the matter and the Board's decision is final. The grantee has until June 1,
- 18 1999, to present evidence satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that a matching fund
- 19 will be provided. If satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact to
- 20 the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan shall be expended for the purposes
- 21 provided in this Act.
- 22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 23 June 1, 1997.
