8 9	(e) (1) The State Fire Prevention Commission shall adopt regulations to establish and administer a fee schedule for:
10 11	(i) Reviewing building plans to ensure compliance with the State Fire Prevention Code; and

	(2) The State Fire Prevention Commission shall review annually the fee schedule adopted under this subsection to ensure that the moneys collected shall at least cover the costs of administering plan review and conducting inspections.
	(3) This subsection may not be construed to limit the authority of a local authority to establish a fee schedule for plan review and inspections conducted by the local authority.

13	(G) (1) AN INDIVIDUAL A PERSON MAY NOT PROVIDE SERVICES AS A FIRE SPRINKLER CONTRACTOR IN THE STATE UNLESS LICENSED BY THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL.
17	(2) <u>AN ORGANIZATION A PERSON</u> MAY NOT PROVIDE SERVICES AS A FIRE SPRINKLER CONTRACTOR UNLESS SUCH SERVICES ARE PROVIDED BY AN EMPLOYER OR CONTRACTOR OF THE <u>ORGANIZATION PERSON</u> WHO IS LICENSED BY THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL.

- 15 by them under the authority thereof shall not apply to or within Baltimore City except
- 16 THOSE PROVISIONS OF §§ 3 AND 8 OF THIS ARTICLE THAT PERTAIN TO THE
- 17 LICENSING OF FIRE SPRINKLER CONTRACTORS AND on properties owned or operated
- 18 by the State of Maryland. The State Fire Code shall apply in Baltimore City to hospitals,
- 19 nursing homes and similar institutions which require State licensure.
