- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 16 9-204.3. <u>2-406.</u>
- 17 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "SPECIAL MEDICAL WASTE" HAS THE MEANING STATED
- 18 IN TITLE 26, SUBTITLE 13, CHAPTER 11 OF THE CODE OF MARYLAND REGULATIONS.
- 19 (B) (D) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL, AT A MINIMUM, CONDUCT QUARTERLY
- 20 INSPECTIONS OF AN INCINERATOR THAT ACCEPTS MORE THAN 50 TONS PER DAY OF
- 21 SPECIAL MEDICAL WASTE, AS DEFINED IN TITLE 26, SUBTITLE 13, CHAPTER 11 OF THE
- 22 CODE OF MARYLAND REGULATIONS, AND MAY UNDERTAKE OTHER ACTIVITIES AS
- 23 <u>NECESSARY</u> EACH DAY TO DETERMINE WHETHER THE OPERATION OF THE
- 24 INCINERATOR MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE AIR QUALITY PERMIT ISSUED
