BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 11 12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 13 **Article - Environment** 14 9-1707. 15 (c) (1) To satisfy the recycled content percentage requirement of this section 16 for a calendar year, at least the percentage specified in paragraph (2) of this subsection, 17 by weight, of the total newsprint used by the publisher during that calendar year for 18 newspapers distributed in the State shall be recycled materials. 19 (2) The recycled content percentage requirement is: 20 (i) 12% for 1992; (ii) 12% for 1993; 21 22 (iii) 20% for 1994, 1995, 1996, 1997, 1998, AND 1999;
