	(b) A person may not falsely represent any food or the contents of any package or container to be kosher or kosher for Passover by having or permitting to be inscribed on 8 it, in any language, the words "kosher", "parve", or "glatt".		
29	(c) (1) In this subsection, "Hebrew symbol" means:
