- 19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 24 inspectors, clerical and other assistance as may be necessary, and to fix the compensation
- 25 of such employees, except as otherwise provided by this article.

- 27 (6) (I) 1. IN THIS PARAGRAPH, "INSPECTORS" MEANS BOTH
- 28 FULL-TIME AND PART-TIME INSPECTORS WHO ARE EMPLOYEES OF THE BOARD

	2. INSPECTORS WHO WERE APPOINTED PRIOR TO OCTOBER 1, 1997, SHALL CONTINUE THEIR APPOINTMENT AFTER THAT DATE UNLESS REMOVED IN ACCORDANCE WITH CLASSIFIED CIVIL SERVICE PROCEDURES.
4	(II) AS OF OCTOBER 1, 1997:
5 6	1. INSPECTORS ARE PART OF THE CLASSIFIED CIVIL SERVICE OF THE CITY;
	2. THE BOARD MAY APPOINT AND REMOVE INSPECTORS ONLY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF LAW THAT GOVERN CLASSIFIED CIVIL SERVICE EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY;
	3. AN EMPLOYEE OF THE BOARD MAY NOT SOLICIT OR RECEIVE, DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY OR ON BEHALF OF ANOTHER PERSON, A COMMISSION, POLITICAL CONTRIBUTION, REMUNERATION, OR GIFT FROM:
13 14	A. A LICENSEE OR OTHER PERSON WHO IS ENGAGED IN THE MANUFACTURE OR SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES; OR
	B. AN AGENT OR EMPLOYEE OF A LICENSEE OR OTHER PERSON WHO IS ENGAGED IN THE MANUFACTURE OR SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES; AND
20	4. AN EMPLOYEE OR OTHER PERSON SPECIFIED IN SUB-SUBPARAGRAPH 3 OF THIS SUBPARAGRAPH WHO VIOLATES THE PROVISIONS OF THAT SUB-SUBPARAGRAPH IS SUBJECT TO THE PENALTIES SPECIFIED IN § 16-503 OF THIS ARTICLE.
24	(III) THE PROVISIONS OF THIS PARAGRAPH DO NOT ALTER THE PROCESS BY WHICH INSPECTORS' SALARIES ARE FUNDED. SALARIES SHALL BE DETERMINED BY THE CITY DEPARTMENT OF PERSONNEL UNDER THE COMPENSATION POLICIES FOR CLASSIFIED EMPLOYEES OF THE BOARD.
	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the provisions of this Act are not intended to have any effect on any legal proceeding that is pending on October 1, 1997.
29 30	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1997.
