- 16 WORKERS THE LIVING WAGE IF THE ANNUAL STATE BUDGET DOES NOT PROVIDE
- 17 SUFFICIENT FUNDING TO IMPLEMENT THE ANNUAL ADJUSTMENT TO THE HOURLY
- 18 REIMBURSEMENT RATE FOR THE DIRECT CARE COMPONENT OF THE
