10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

11 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

12 Article - Labor and Employment

13 3-413.

- Except as provided in § 3-414 of this subtitle, each employer shall pay:
- 15 (1) to each employee who is subject to both the Federal Act and this 16 subtitle, at least THE GREATER OF:
- 17 (I) the minimum wage for that employee under the Federal Act; OR
- 18 (II) A WAGE THAT EQUALS A RATE OF \$6.60 PER HOUR; and
- 19 (2) each other employee who is subject to this subtitle, at least THE
- 20 GREATER OF:
- 21 (i) the highest minimum wage under the Federal Act;
- 22 (II) A WAGE THAT EQUALS A RATE OF \$6.60 PER HOUR; or
- 23 [(ii)] (III) a training wage under regulations that the Commissioner
- 24 adopts that include the conditions and limitations authorized under the federal Fair
- 25 Labor Standards Amendments of 1989.
- 26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 27 October 1, 1997.
