12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

15 15-112.

16 (f-1) (1) [In] THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES ONLY IN Caroline County[, the].

17 (2) (I) THE county codes administrator is the inspector for the Board of
18 License Commissioners.

19 [(2)] (II) The salary of the inspector shall be as provided in the county
20 budget. The duties of the inspector shall be as specified by the Board, including the
21 proper administration and enforcement of the alcoholic beverages laws of Caroline
22 County.

23 (3) (I) THE BOARD MAY APPOINT AN ATTORNEY.

24 (II) THE SALARY SHALL BE SET BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.

25 (III) THE ATTORNEY IS SUBJECT TO THE COUNTY ETHICS
26 ORDINANCE.

27 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
28 October 1, 1997.
