2 **Caroline County - Alcoholic Beverages**  
3 **(Board of License Commissioners - Attorney)**

4 FOR the purpose of ~~creating and generally relating to the position of attorney to the~~  
5 authorizing the Board of License Commissioners of Caroline County to appoint and  
6 set compensation for an attorney for the Board; providing that the attorney is  
7 subject to the county ethics ordinance; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages  
8 in Caroline County.

9 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
10 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages  
11 Section 15-112(f-1)  
12 Annotated Code of Maryland  
13 (1996 Replacement Volume)

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

17 15-112.

18 (f-1) (1) [In] THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES ONLY IN Caroline County[, the].

19 (2) (I) THE county codes administrator is the inspector for the Board of  
20 License Commissioners.

21 [(2)] (II) The salary of the inspector shall be as provided in the county  
22 budget. The duties of the inspector shall be as specified by the Board, including the

1 proper administration and enforcement of the alcoholic beverages laws of Caroline  
2 County.

3 (3) (I) THE BOARD MAY APPOINT AN ATTORNEY FOR THE BOARD.

4 (II) THE ~~SALARY~~ COMPENSATION FOR THE ATTORNEY SHALL BE  
5 SET BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.

6 (III) THE ATTORNEY IS SUBJECT TO THE COUNTY ETHICS  
7 ORDINANCE.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
9 October 1, 1997.
