2 **Dorchester County - State's Attorney - Salary Adjustment**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the salary of the State's Attorney for Dorchester County;
4 providing that this Act may not be construed to increase or diminish the salary or
5 compensation of the incumbent or any future State's Attorney for Dorchester
6 County during the term of office as State's Attorney; and generally relating to the
7 salary of the State's Attorney for Dorchester County.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article 10 - Legal Officials**

17 (j) (1) In Dorchester County, the State's Attorney's salary shall be [75] 85
18 percent of the salary of a judge of the District Court of Maryland.

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III,
20 Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to increase or
21 diminish the salary or compensation of the incumbent or any future State's Attorney for
22 Dorchester County during the term of office of the State's Attorney for Dorchester
23 County.
