A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Creation of a State Debt - World War II Memorial Commission

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of \$300,000,
- 4 the proceeds to be used as a grant to the World War II Memorial Commission for
- 5 certain acquisition, development, or improvement purposes; providing for
- 6 disbursement of the loan proceeds; and providing generally for the issuance and
- 7 sale of bonds evidencing the loan.
- 8 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 9 MARYLAND, That:
- 10 (1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on
- 11 behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the World War II
- 2 Memorial Commission Loan of 1997 in the total principal amount of \$300,000. This loan
- 13 shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State general obligation bonds
- 14 authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued, sold, and delivered in
- 15 accordance with §§ 8-117 through 8-124 of the State Finance and Procurement Article
- 16 and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
- 17 (2) The bonds to evidence this loan or installments of this loan may be sold as a
- 18 single issue or may be consolidated and sold as part of a single issue of bonds under §
- 19 8-122 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
- 20 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer and
- 21 first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and delivering the
- 22 bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then shall be credited on
- 23 the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the Board of Public Works,
- 24 for the following public purposes, including any applicable architects' and engineers' fees:
- 25 as a grant to the World War II Memorial Commission for the planning, design, and
- 26 construction, together with any necessary excavation, landscaping, and other auxiliary
- 27 improvements, of a memorial to honor Marylanders who served in World War II.
- 28 (4) An annual State tax is imposed on all assessable property in the State in rate
- 29 and amount sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds, as and when due
- 30 and until paid in full. The principal shall be discharged within 15 years after the date of
- 31 issuance of the bonds.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 June 1, 1997.
