- 16 IN A TRIAL OF A PERSON FOR MURDER IN THE FIRST DEGREE IN WHICH THE
- 17 STATE SEEKS A SENTENCE OF DEATH, ON REQUEST OF THE DEFENDANT, THE JUDGE
- 18 SHALL INSTRUCT THE JURY THAT THE DECISION OF THE JURY MUST BE MADE
- 19 WITHOUT REGARD TO THE RACE OF THE DEFENDANT OR THE RACE OF THE VICTIM.
- 20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 21 October 1, 1997.
