2 Workers' Compensation Insurance - Notice of Cancellation

3 FOR the purpose of altering the manner in which an insurer must serve notice of

4 intention to cancel a workers' compensation insurance policy on the employer.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 13 Article Insurance
- 14 19-406.

15 (a) An insurer may not cancel a workers' compensation insurance policy before its 16 expiration unless, at least 30 days before the date of cancellation, the insurer:

(1) serves on the employer, by personal service or [registered] CERTIFIED
mail addressed to the last known address of the employer, a notice of intention to cancel
the policy; and

20 (2) files a copy of the notice with the State Workers' Compensation21 Commission.

22 (b) Notice under this section may be given:

- (1) if the employer is a corporation, to an agent or officer of the corporationon whom legal process may be served; and
- 25 (2) if the employer is a partnership, to a partner.
- 26 (c) Notice under this section shall state when the cancellation takes effect.

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- 1 (d) Whenever an employer receives a notice under this section, the employer
- 2 immediately shall secure coverage in accordance with § 9-402 of the Labor and
- 3 Employment Article that will be in effect when the cancellation takes effect.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 5 October 1, 1997.
