18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 Article - Health - General

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a minor who is at least 17 years old,without the consent of a parent, may give blood to a program that:

24	(1) Is voluntary;
25	(2) Does not pay money for the blood; and
26	(3) Is approved by:
27	(i) The American Association of Blood Banks; or
28	(ii) The American Red Cross.]

2 (A) A PERSON MAY NOT TAKE A DONATION OF BLOOD FROM A MINOR UNTIL
3 THE PERSON RECEIVES THE WRITTEN CONSENT OF A PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN
4 OF THE MINOR.

5 (B) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION IS SUBJECT6 TO A CIVIL FINE NOT TO EXCEED \$500 FOR EACH VIOLATION.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 July 1, 1997.
